### General Rules:

#### Contest and Programming Rules:

- The University level contest will be conducted at RGPV on-line computer labs using the same contest platform over Internet used in round 1 and 2.
- Only one computer is allotted to single team during contest.
- No mobile phone or other data device is permitted inside computer lab.
- Coaches are not allowed inside the lab.
- Do not consult with anyone outside your team, copy other teams' answers, try to hack into the server, etc. All that is considered cheating.
- No teams are allowed to enter the lab after the contest start.

  - ☒ Do NOT post a comment asking why your solution is wrong.
  - ☒ Do NOT post a comment asking if you can be given the test case your program fails on.
  - ☒ Do NOT post a comment asking how your solution can be improved.
  - ☒ Do NOT post a comment giving any hints or discussing approaches to the problem, or what type or speed of algorithm is required.
  - ☒ The ONLY time you should be posting a comment is if you do not understand the problem statement. Before asking for a clarification, read the problem statement several times.
